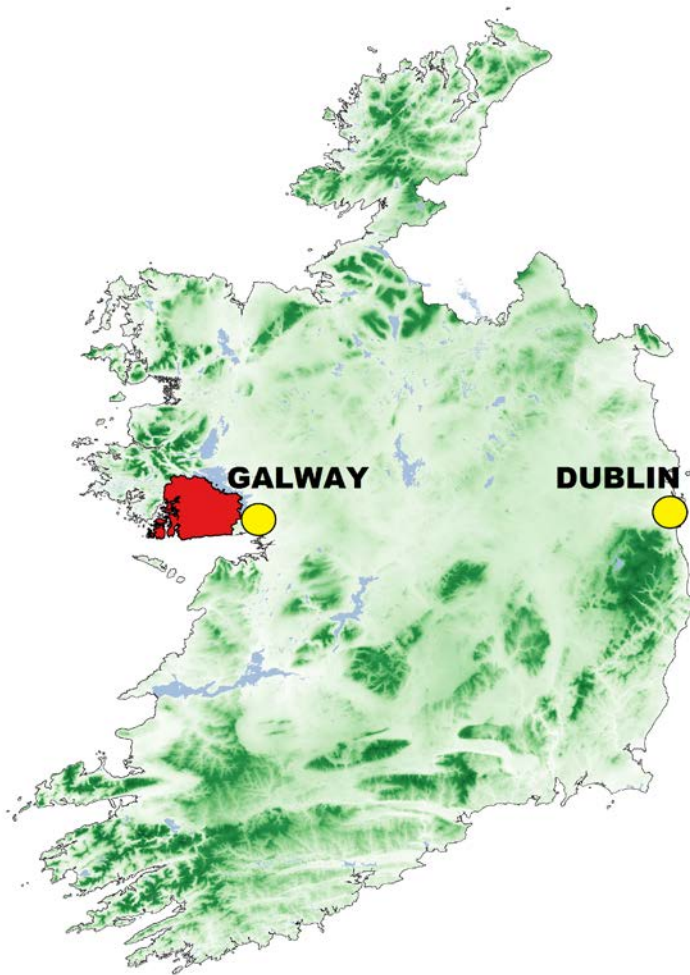

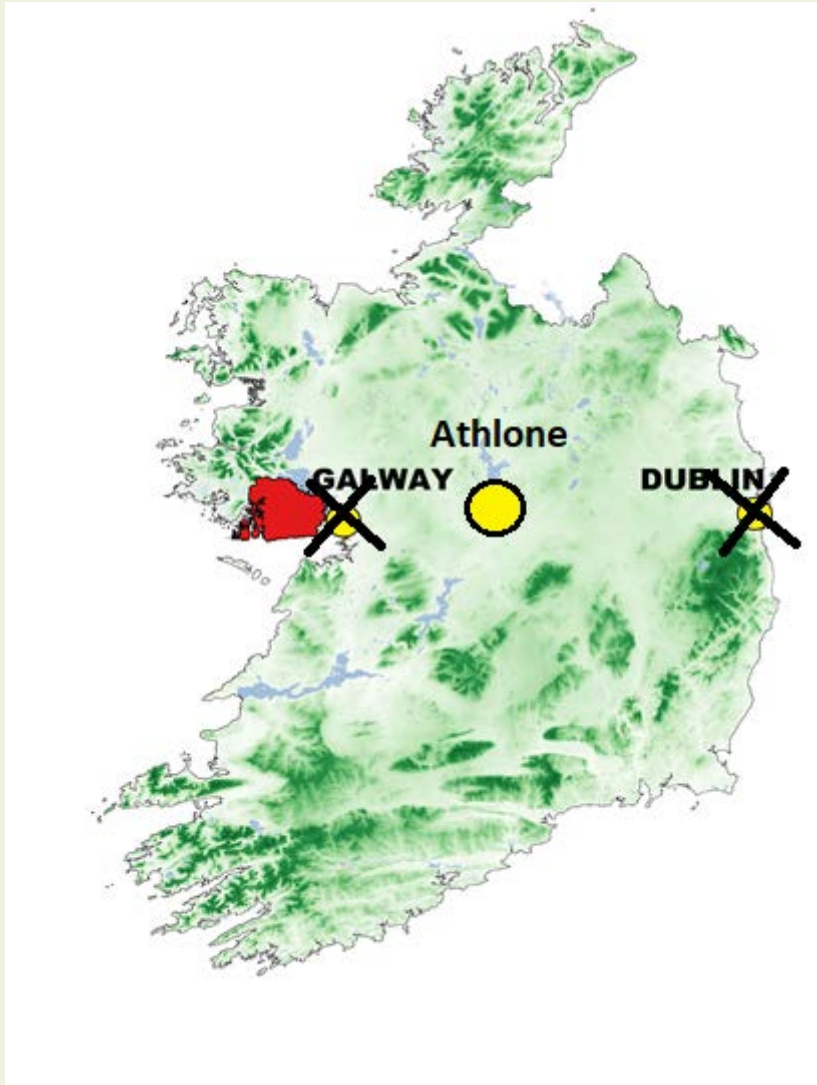


Old idea

Implementation of aFMM

- Coillte theoretically have lots of power to implement aFMMs
- Want to find new management solutions to blanket peat forestry
- Low stock LP already in the future plan and good alternative
- Bog restoration tried near CSA, but need external funding
